Responsibilities

- Visit encampments and go on street rounds with medical professionals and social workers upon request to assist in promoting health.
- Assist in developing programs to address needs identified in the Community Health Needs Assessment
- Proactively identify programs and services that would be useful to people experiencing homelessness and assist in the development of those programs and services
- Participate in Community Health Needs Assessment and other MACH OneHealth meetings

Skills and Qualifications

- People with lived experience of houselessness encouraged to apply.
- A passion for ending houselessness and working with people without permanent housing.
- Commitment to maintaining confidentiality of our program participants.
- Ability to learn confidentiality and HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) rules and follow them.
- Ability to read and respond to emails on a daily basis. Devices and internet resources available/provided.
- Ability to attend trainings Ability to attend Homeless Services Consortium and MACH OneHealth meetings (in person and via Zoom)
- Knowledge of the Madison community
- Familiarity and experience working with community-based agencies, homeless services programs and an ability to learn about government or social services agencies that assist people without homes.
- Ability to work collaboratively in partnership with nonprofits, public agencies and other stakeholders.
- Experience in engaging with individuals and families experiencing houselessness
- Ability to function as part of a cross-disciplinary team
- Organizational skills Ability to multitask and work on multiple projects
- Ability to have positive working relationships with people of diverse racial/ethnic, socio-economic, and educational backgrounds.
- Commitment to the mission of a small, volunteer driven non-profit organization.
- Ability to have a flexible schedule.
- Bilingual in Spanish or ASL a plus.
